3.0 Review Invoices

Amanda Steimonts provided the committee members with a detailed breakdown of the bond budget and expenditures-to-date. Our total budget is \$8,004,884.56 which represents the original \$4 million bond and the additional \$4 million matching funds provided by OSCIM (Oregon School Capital Improvement Matching).

As of 11-30-23, we have expended a total of \$5,232,559.72.

At this time there are no projects that can be shared; once more progress has been made, photos and information will continue to be shared on the District Facebook page and on the website to keep community members informed of the bond progress.

5.0 Future Projects Update


Executive Director of Operations Brent Robertson updated the committee on Bus Barn project. It's come to a standstill over rising costs. He and Superintendent Shauna Schmerer are scheduled to have a meeting with ZCS Engineering on January 12, 2023 to discuss obstacles in moving forward with this project.
